If you are ...

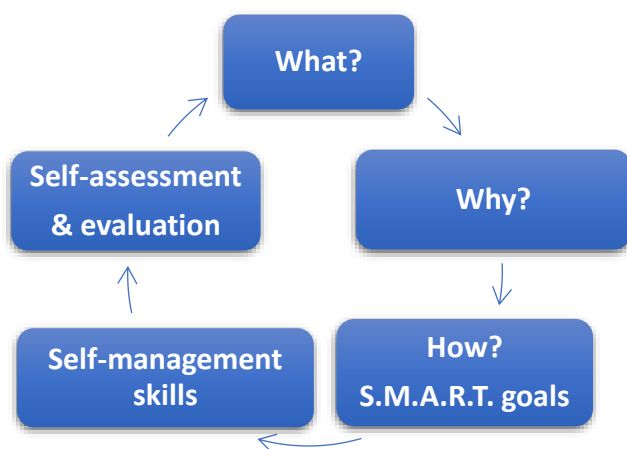
- Overweight with the Body Mass Index (MBI) over 25
